End of Key Stage 2 Pupil Results 2019

2018 / 2019 the standards achieved at the end of KS2 are above Local and National Averages:

The percentage of pupil's achieving the expected standard is a combined measure across three subjects (Reading, Writing and Maths). To be counted towards the measure, a pupil must have a scaled **score of 100** or more in reading **and** a scaled score of 100 or more in maths **and** have been teacher assessed in writing as 'working at the expected standard' or 'working at a greater depth in the expected standard'.
