KITKAT many people's Favourite Snack



Nestle have announced KitKats will no longer be Fairtrade. From October they will stop buying from cocoa and sugar farmers in Cote d'Ivoire, Fiji and Malawi on Fairtrade terms. That means ripping away around £2 million of annual Fairtrade Premium payments, in the middle of a huge health and economic crisis. Farmers will be getting less for their hard work and have less control over how they spend their money. This can't be right, especially when Nestle turned a profit of over \$10 billion last year.

We are a Fairtrade Church, please tell Nestle's CEO that we want KitKat to stay Fairtrade. Go to

OUR FIRST PUBLIC MASS WILL BE ON MONDAY 6th JULY AT 9:30am IF POSSIBLE PLEASE TRY TO ATTEND MASS DURING THE WEEK RATHER THAN ON SUNDAYS

THE CHURCH WILL BE OPEN 20 mins BEFORE EACH MASS. ONCE MASS HAS BEGUN NO ONE WILL BE ABLE TO ENTER THE CHURCH

Coming to Mass will feel a little different than usual. The wearing of a face mask is not compulsory but feel free to do so. Father will wear one for the distribution of Holy Communion. Please also be aware of the following:

- 1 On arrival you will need to sanitise your hands.
- 2 You will then be guided by the stewards to sit in a particular place. Your 'usual seats' will not be available.
- 3 If you wish to light candles please do so **BEFORE MASS.**
- 4 You will stay in your place and Holy Communion will be brought to you.
- 5 At the end of Mass you will be dismissed row by row by the stewards. Sanitise your hands on leaving and please **DO NOT** congregate in the car park after Mass.

MASSES AT HOLY FAMILY

At this time it is sadly not possible to open Holy Family Church for public Masses. It has been quite a challenge to get one church prepared and meeting all the regulations let alone two. For the time being private prayer and public Masses will be at Sacred Heart Church only. The diocese has not yet inspected Holy Family Church and would prefer we concentrate on having each parish church open before opening second churches in a parish. If we can gather sufficient volunteers then we can look at the opening of Holy Family Church at some point in the future. It upsets me to have to put it like this as I like to be as fair as I can in the provision given to both our churches but there is a lot of work involved and if we fail to meet all the requirements we run the risk of being told to close again which would be awful.

THE COLLECTION ENVELOPES
